

1. Towels

Getting to Warmwell

Warmwell is located a 6 miles from Weymouth and Dorchester, Dorset, and if you're not been to us before, you're in for a treat. The park is in an idyllic countryside setting with deer, ducks and fishing lakes.

BY CAR...

Address: Warmwell Holiday Park, Near Weymouth, Dorset, DT2 8JF (Sat Nav will take you directly there, or if it doesn't just go along the road by another 200 yards!)

M25 > M3 > M27 > A31 > A35 > B3390; or

If you're coming from the West, M5 > A30 > A35 > B3390

From North and West Follow ring road around Dorchester and head towards Poole. Take 1st turning on the right A352 towards Wareham. At 1st roundabout take the 3rd exit and at 2nd roundabout take 1st exit towards Crossways. At the T - Junction turn left under the railway bridge. Carry on towards Crossways and at the T - junction turn right. Park is 1 mile on the right. From East - Pick up the A35 towards Dorchester. Take the 1st exit of the dual carriageway on to the B3390 and follow signs to Warmwell. Continue over the railway crossing and park is 4 miles on the right. (DT2 8JE)

BY TRAIN...

Nearest station - Moreton - about one and a half miles from the park. Main lines - London Waterloo-Southampton-Bournemouth-Weymouth. Check other routes too from West. For all train enquiries contact National Rail Enquiries on 0845 748 4950. http://ojp.nationalrail.co.uk/service/planjourney/search. Moreton is a small train station, and we recommend you pre-book your taxi. Taxi Firm X-Ways Taxis on 01305-854719. Alternatively, check with people you know who are going to Warmwell, perhaps they could pick you up.



Lodge Keys

Lodges have 2 keys, however, a 3rd key can be ordered by completing an online form - go to www.mjroc.com/3rdkeyorder

We will give keys 1, 2 (and 3 if ordered) to the first 3 people who turn up to check in. However, there is a £5 deposit on ALL keys, which will be returned to you when you hand the key back in at the end of the weekend.

If you are in a male/female shared lodge, we will order a 3rd key for you automatically.

You can hand your keys back in at Reception until 5pm on Sunday - after that, you can hand them into the Bar staff (til 1am) who will return your deposit. Reception is then open from 8am on Monday.

If you are leaving after 1am on Sunday/Monday, we advise you to give your key to a lodge mate who will then return the key for you to get your £5 deposit back. Nicky, Colin or Gazza cannot take your key and return your deposit.
