

COVID ENTRY DISCUSSIONS

Warmwell 2021 Covid Protocol

Those attending MJRoc Warmwell November 26-29th 2021, will be required to produce approved (NHS/Gov.uk) proof of taking at **least two lateral flow tests** in the week of/before Warmwell, which both show "Negative results (not with Covid symptoms)".

ONE / First Lateral Flow Test is self-taken on either 23rd or 24th of November 2021 and the results uploaded immediately to the Gov.uk site or by ringing NHS 119. They will then email and text you immediately.

TWO / Then on **Friday 26th November** before you leave for Warmwell, you must complete the **2nd self-taken Lateral Flow Test**, again to show **Negative** and again you must immediately upload the results to Gov.uk or call NHS 119. They will then email and text you immediately.

PROOF/ Ensure you have the proof before travelling to Warmwell as you will be required to declare this on arrival.

No Proof, no entry.

Proof in form of the NHS App, NHS/Gov.uk Text and NHS/Gov.uk email must be shown on arrival to Warmwell. Plus approved Photo ID.

HOW TO GET YOUR LATERAL FLOW KITS / You can order your **free Lateral Flow Kits** via this [Link](#) (they arrive normally with 2 days by post) or collect from your local chemists straight away.



ORDERED ONLINE? You will get an order confirmation email soon. Your pack of rapid lateral flow home test kits should arrive within 2 days.

If there are any delays, call contact centre (details also in your confirmation email).

Call 119 Free from mobiles and landlines

Lines open 7am to 11pm

What is in the test pack

The pack contains:

- 7 rapid lateral flow home test kits
- instructions on how to take the test
- instructions on how to report each result to the NHS

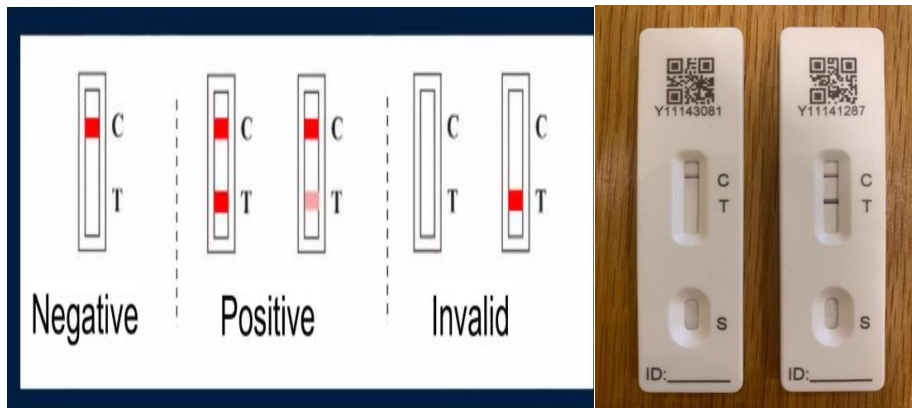
When the test pack arrives

You should:

- report every result to the NHS on the same day you take the test

You will need to report your Negative results immediately with this [LINK](#)

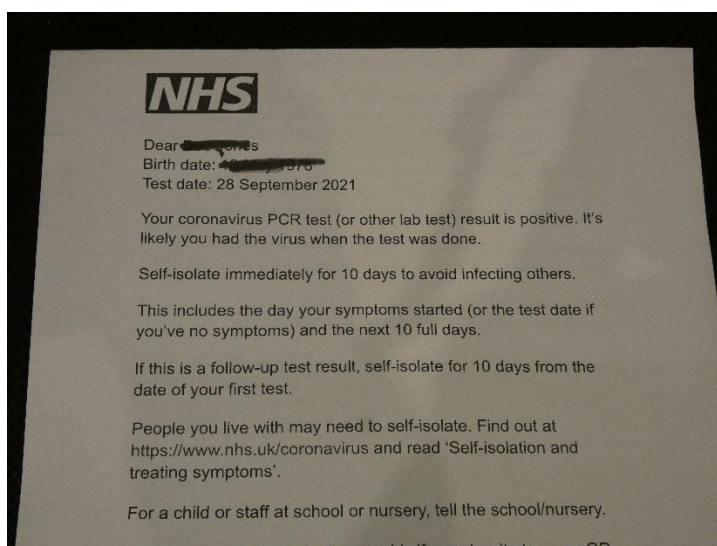


A third Lateral Flow Test maybe required on arrival at check in by everyone or on an individual basis, so please ensure you have brought your test kits with you in case you are all/individually required to do so.

HAD COVID?

If you have contracted Covid, you would have reported this ([Gov.uk](#)) **NHS 119** and took a **PCR test** to prove you were "**Positive- with Covid**". [NHS provides Proof with Document.](#)

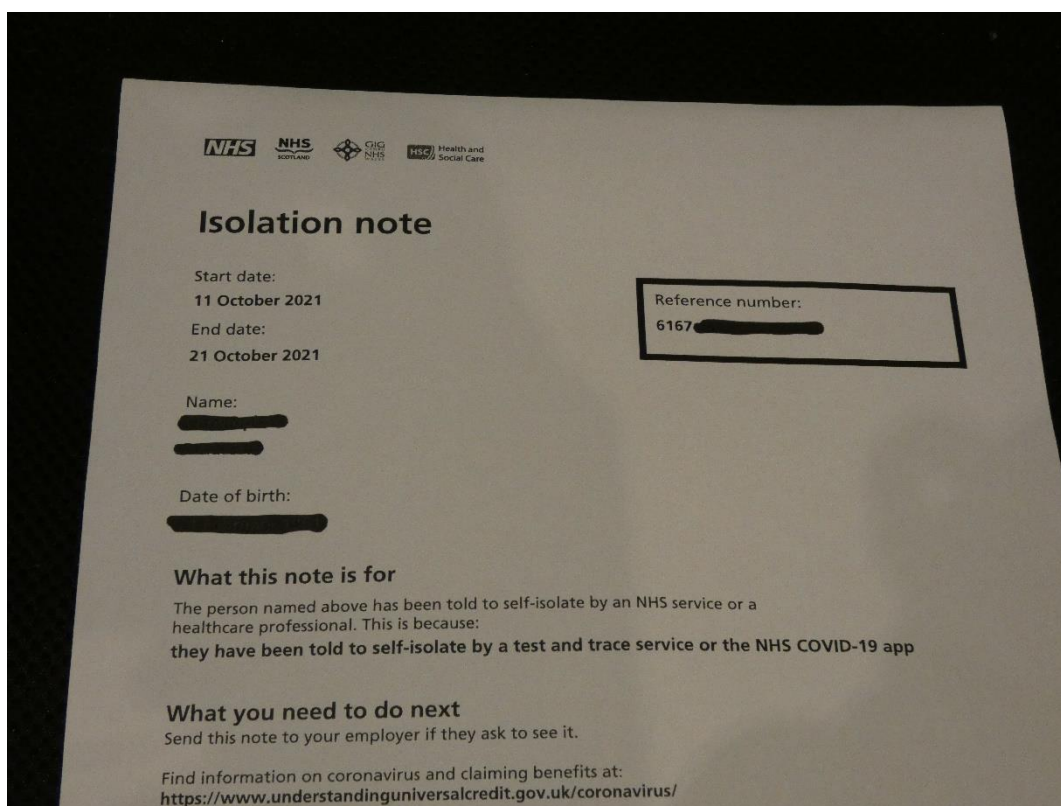
The Document must clearly show with your full name, Date of Birth and the date you were positive with Covid.



Do not rely on a text as some are not acceptable as do not have this information.

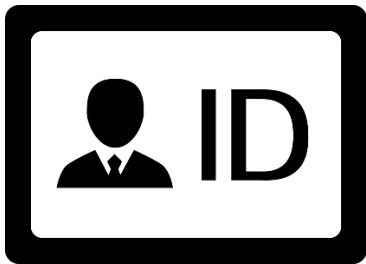
Once you have completed the Ten Days Isolation period required, you will have received proof with your name on it and this **document** must be provided on arrival at Warmwell (with your Photo ID).

You require the Isolation Note from NHS. The Document must clearly show with your full name, the date you were positive with Covid and the date you completed the ten-day isolation period.



If you do not have this proof, you must call NHS 119 to obtain this immediately to obtain it, as it may come by text, email or post. Or you can online download from NHS 111 [LINK](https://111.nhs.uk/isolation-note/)

Photo ID must be shown on arrival by everyone



Then either or.

A/ **Proof of two Negative** Lateral Flow Tests as above.

OR

B/**Proof of Positive PCR Test** results in last 90 days and that you have completed the 10 days isolation and showing no more symptoms. (As above)

Valid proof must be brought with you (1) **Full Proof of PCR test and (2) Isolation NHS Note completion** after the ten day isolation period. (As discussed as required above)

Everyone must bring a valid **Photo ID**.

MUST BRING. You must bring both white test strips from the tests, also known as the white stick or cassette. This should be placed in the self sealed clear bag in the test kits or another clear bag. (if you can write on the test strip, even better)



If the UK Government makes changes and introduces a Covid Pass requirement at short notice, this is outside MJRoc's control.

There are no exceptions or exemptions.

All attendees must adhere to the event instructions.

This is allowed by the Equality Act 2010 as a proportionate means of achieving a legitimate aim of ensuring that everyone in attendance is at a lower-risk of transmitting COVID-19 to others.

During the event

Frequently use hand sanitiser provided.

Wash your hands regularly.

Masks Wearing is optional for all.

Respect peoples choices in whom they dance with.

UNWELL DURING THE EVENT?

Respect your fellow dancers: do not enter the dance venue.

Call reception or text the MJRoc number.

Please inform if you have left the site to go home.
